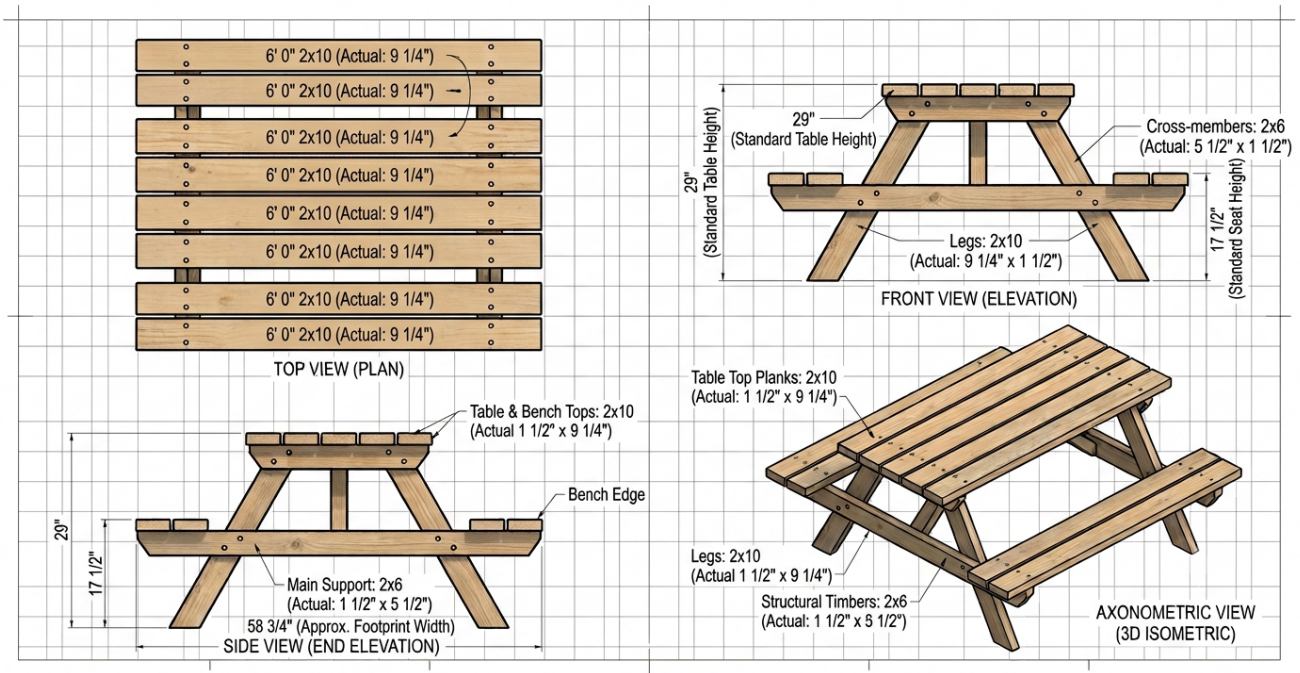


# Outdoor Picnic Table

## Overview

---

This is an Example, not a very good one

Outdoor picnic table made from construction lumber. seats 6 people.

### Materials

---

#### Lumber & sheet goods

- 13 × Common — 2x6

### Tools

---

- Miter saw (or: Circular saw)
- Drill (or: Impact driver)

## Build steps

---

### Step 1 — Step 1: Table length cuts

Cut 9 2x6s to the desired table length. 6' is a good length for a 6 person table (~2ft per person for each side). Miter saw is easiest for these cuts.

---

### Step 2 — Step 2: Battons

cut 3 battons from 2x4

29.5" long with 31 degree miter

---

### Step 3 — Step 3: Cut legs

Cut legs from 2x6s

cut 6 31" lengths with 33 degree miters

---

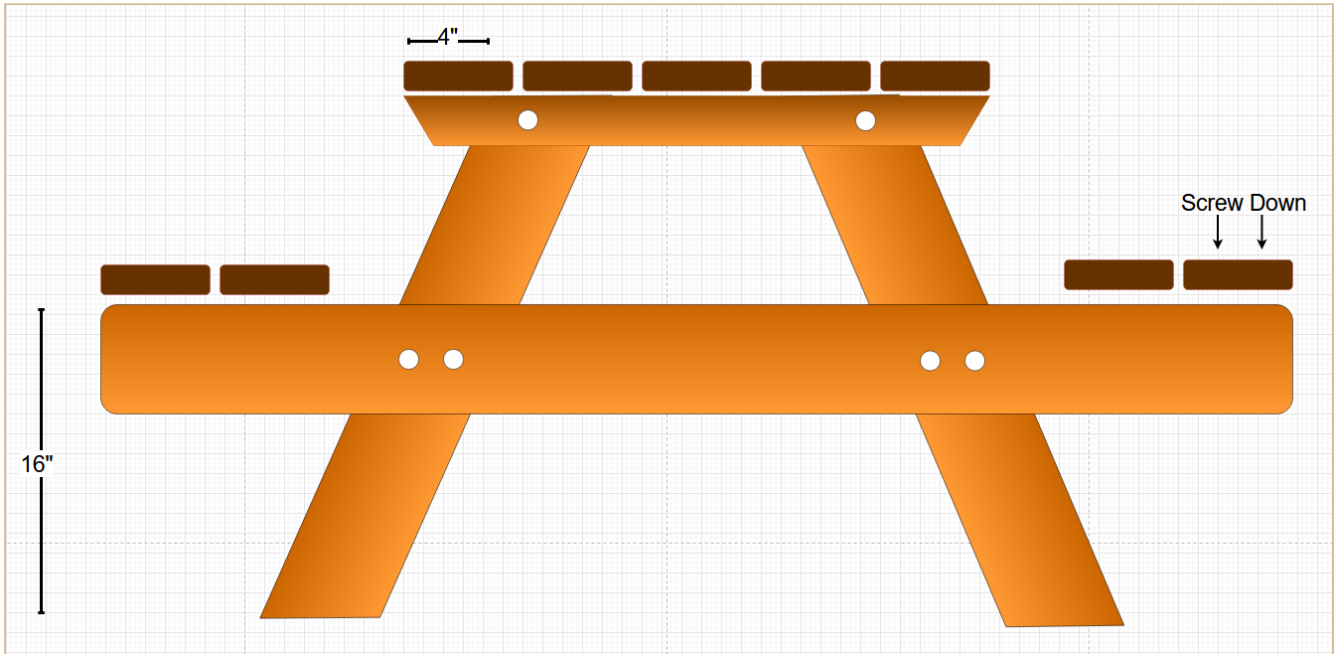
### Step 4 — Step 4: Seat Supports

cut 3 2x6s 5'

---

## Step 5 — Step 5: Assemble

build sets of legs and support. Join with 3/8" x 3 1/2" carriage bolts  
screw down seats and table top
